## Artist Agreement

The Bead Rescue Project is looking for artists to donate beads to the project.

We would love to share your beads! Beads will be accepted from any artist in the society. The Project may have started in The Midrealm, but we are hoping to attend events in other kingdoms as well! There are a few things that we need from you in order to include your beads in our project. The first of the forms below is an agreement to participate in the program. The second form below is needed with each batch of beads you send, so that we may identify the beads and mark them accordingly.

The first form, you will only need to print, sign and send me once. It is an agreement stating that you understand the program and that you will be notified of any changes via email. You will be listed with any contact info you wish to include on the website, along with a picture which I will contact you for once I receive your agreement. I would LOVE help at the project table if you are attending any of the events at which beads are being released! It would be awesome for the new owners to be able to meet the artists participating and making their beads!

You are also welcome to withdraw from the project at any time, just notify me, Rois ( Suzann Fine )

The second form will need to be printed and sent to me with every set of beads you send. We do ask that all beads be cleaned out and annealed if at all possible. We are also asking that all beads be made to recreate a documentable bead from a book or website. When those finding the beads come to the table, they will get an information card giving them the book name, page the picture is found on, and basic information for the bead, as well as the artist who created the bead. This is all requested on the second form below. All information must be included in order to release the beads through the project.

We are very excited about this project and can't wait to share all of the wonderful beads we make with the rest of the Society! We are looking forward to sharing a variety of beads from all periods, cultures and artists!

## The Bead Rescue Project - Artist Agreement

We ask that you as the artist agree to the following:

- First and foremost, this program is totally voluntary and there is no financial reimbursement for any of the beads donated.
- All beads will be created after a documentable picture of a real period bead either in a book or from a website, and that you will include this information with the bead when you send it. This information will be included along with your name and contact info if you want it on the bead's information card.
  - All beads will be cleaned out.
  - All beads will be annealed if at all possible.
- Only contact information that you wish to be shared, will be shared on the website or any other materials from The Bead Rescue Project.
  - We will work to insure all artists with donated beads will be equally represented at any given event.
- Some of the details regarding the program are subject to change, and you will be notified immediately of any changes. If you should decide you no longer want to participate, we will remove you from the artist list and return your beads to you immediately.
